- A Perform a GVI of the Flight Deck Sidewalls and Jump Seat Area.
- B Clean the Flight Deck Sidewalls and Jump Seat Area (access behind jump seat if they are folded up) utilizing an all-purpose cleaner and lint free cloth.
- C If necessary, remove and discard beverage containers, food wrappers or other debris placed in sidewall recesses.

_____ XXXXX 4 Clean Forward Control Area Including Indication Display Surfaces.

- A Perform a General Visual Inspection of the Flight Deck Floor and Pedal Area for cleanliness and condition.
