1. Flashlight Check

\_\_\_\_\_ XXXXX A. Procedure - for each installed flashlight

Note: Reference EEL placard on back of flight compartment door for location of flashlights.

- (1) Make sure the indicator light (an LED) on the side of the flashlight flashes a minimum of once every ten seconds.

NOTE: If the indicator light flashes less than once every ten seconds, then the batteries are weak. If the indicator light flashes too dimly to see clearly in good light, then the batteries are weak.

- (2) If the indicator light flashes less than once every ten seconds, then replace the flashlight.
- (3) Remove the flashlight from the mounting bracket.
- (4) Make sure the light comes on.
- (5) Install the flashlight in the mounting bracket.
